

## Website navigation information

Information provided pursuant to Articles 13 and 14 of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 (hereinafter also: "Regulation" or **GDPR**) to those who access the Organization's website.

### DATA CONTROLLER

The Data Controller is RM PONTEROSSO SPA, with registered office at Via Del Trifoglio 17, 30175 Venice.

#### Personal data processed, purposes, and legal basis

- a. **Browsing data:** The computer systems and software procedures used to operate this website acquire, during their normal operation, some personal data whose transmission is implicit in the use of Internet communication protocols. This information is not collected to be associated with identified data subjects, but by its very nature could, through processing and association with data held by third parties, allow users to be identified. This category of data includes the IP addresses or domain names of computers used by users connecting to the site, the URI (Uniform Resource Identifier) addresses of requested resources, the time of the request, the method used to submit the request to the server, the size of the file obtained in response, the numerical code indicating the status of the response from the server (successful, error, etc.), and other parameters relating to the user's operating system and IT environment. This data is used solely to obtain anonymous statistical information on site usage and to monitor its proper functioning, and is retained for the periods established by applicable legislation. The data may be used to ascertain liability in the event of hypothetical cybercrimes against the site. Purpose: site operation and improvement, security.   2. **To apply in the "Work with us" section:** Name, Surname, Address, City, Province, Country, Telephone, Email, and CV (if applicable). Legal basis: pre-contractual measures (Article 6, paragraph 1, letter b). See the information for candidates.

#### Methods, storage times and place of processing.

Your personal data will be processed in a manner that ensures adequate security and confidentiality and prevents unauthorized access or use. Therefore, your personal data will be processed and stored in full compliance with the principles of data necessity, data minimization, and retention period limitation, through the adoption of technical and organizational measures appropriate to the level of risk of the processing and for a period of time no longer than necessary to achieve the purposes for which they are processed, and in any case for the period required by law. Detailed information on data retention is provided in the specific notices cited above. The data is processed in Italy and is not subject to transfer to non-EU countries.

### **Rights of interested parties**

Among the rights that may be exercised, provided that the conditions set forth by the applicable legislation are met (specifically, Articles 15 et seq. of the Regulation), the data subject may at any time: obtain from the Data Controller, where applicable, access to their personal data and the rectification or erasure of such data, restriction of processing concerning them, object to processing, or withdraw consent (without prejudice to the lawfulness of processing prior to withdrawal). Requests must be submitted in writing to the Data Controller by email to the email address provided.

**Right to complain:** Interested parties who believe that the processing of their personal data through this site violates the Regulation have the right to lodge a complaint with the Data Protection Authority, pursuant to Article 77 of the Regulation, or to take appropriate legal action (Article 79 of the Regulation).
